## Entry Level Writing Requirement (ELWR)

The University of California requires undergraduate students to meet ELWR, which demonstrates a minimum proficiency in English composition.

The following criteria will meet the ELWR:

AP English	score of 3 or higher
SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing	score of 680 or higher
SAT Reasoning Test, Writing Section	score of 680 or higher
ACT English Language Arts	score of 30 or higher
ACT English plus Reading (effective for students entering Fall 2021)	score of 63 or higher
IB Higher Level English A	score of 5 or higher
IB Standard Level English A	score of 6 or higher
English Composition completed prior to enrollment at UC San Diego	grade of C or higher

Take the Math Placement Exam as early as possible unless you have met one of these placement criteria:

SAT Math Test	Qualifying Score	Course Placement
SAT Math Level 2	Score of 600 or higher	MATH 4C or 10A
SAT Math Level 2	Score of 650 or higher	MATH 20A, 18
AP Mathematics	Qualifying Score	Course Placement
AP Calculus AB	Score of 2	MATH 4C or 10A
AP Calculus AB	Score of 3	MATH 10B or 20A, 18
AP Calculus AB	Score of 4 or 5	MATH 10B or 20B, 18
AP Calculus BC	Score of 3	MATH 10C or 20B
AP Calculus BC	Score of 4 or 5	MATH 10C or 20C, 18
IB Mathematics	Qualifying Score	Course Placement
IB Math Higher Level	Score of 5	MATH 10B or 20B
