Only Higher Level Exams are accepted for credit by the University of California; Standard Level Exams are not granted credit. Score of 6 or 7 on Standard Level English A exam meets UC Entry Level Writing requirement but no unit credit is granted. The University of California grants 8 quarter units of credit for International Baccalaureate Higher Level exams on which a student scores 5 or higher, according to the chart below, and 6 quarter units of credit for the IB Diploma when a student earns a score of 30 or more. For IB exams not listed here, consult an academic advisor. College courses taken before or after attending UC may duplicate IB examinations. Additionally, exams may duplicate each other (for example, AP and IB exams in the same subject area). If a student duplicates an exam with another exam of the same subject content, and/or an exam with a college course, credit will only be awarded once.
