Entry Level Writing Requirement (ELWR)

The University of California requires undergraduate students to meet ELWR, which demonstrates a minimum proficiency in English composition.

The following criteria will meet ELWR:

AP English, Seminar, or Research	score of 3 or higher
SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (valid through 2/29/24)	score of 680 or higher
ACT English Language Arts	score of 30 or higher
ACT English plus Reading	score of 63 or higher
IB Higher Level English A	score of 5 or higher
IB Standard Level English A	score of 6 or higher
English Composition completed prior to enrollment at UC San Diego	grade of C or higher

Math Placement Criteria

Take the Math Placement Exam as early as possible unless you have met one of these placement criteria:

AP Mathematics	Qualifying Score	Course Placement
AP Precalculus	score of 4	MATH 4C or 10A
AP Precalculus	score of 5	MATH 10A or 20A, 18
AP Calculus AB	score of 2	MATH 4C or 10A
AP Calculus AB	score of 3	MATH 10B or 20A (for 2 units), 18
AP Calculus AB	score of 4 or 5	MATH 10B or 20B, 18
AP Calculus BC	score of 3	MATH 10C or 20B (for 2 units), 11, 18
AP Calculus BC	score of 4 or 5	MATH 10C or 20C, 11, 18
IB Mathematics	Qualifying Score	Course Placement
IB Mathematics Analyses & Approaches Higher Level	score of 5 or higher	MATH 10C or 20B, 11, 18
Equivalent Course Credit
